The 6-Step Lawn Care Program

A Proven Six-Step Approach

- Crabgrass Pre-emergent Fertilizer

 March Early April: Treatment with broadleaf weed control.
- Liquid Weed Control with Light Fertilizer

 May: Provides post emergent control for dandelions,
 clover, chickweed, and many other weeds.
- Spring Fertilizer

 May June: Enhances turf growth and greening prior to the stress of summer heat.

- Insect Control with Light Fertilizer

 June July: Controls multiple varieties of lawn damaging insects.
- Early Fall Fertilizer

 September October: Ideal for recovering from the heat stress of summer. Promotes new growth from established turf and provides the necessary nutrients for fall seeding.
- Winterization Fertilizer
 October November: Nourishes the lawn throughout winter months and provides for quick spring green-up.

Deluxe Lawn Care Package

Crabgrass Pre-emergent Fertilizer March - Early April: Treatment with broadleaf weed control.

Liquid Weed Control with Light Fertilizer April - May: Provides post emergent control for dandelions, clovers, chickweed, and many other weeds.

Soil Testing April - May: Provides an excellent measure of soil fertility and the amount of available nutrients in the soil. A detailed lab analysis will be provided.

Crabgrass Pre-emergent Fertilizer May - June: Enhances turf growth and greening prior to the stress of summer heat.

Preventive Fungicide #1 May - June: Offers full-spectrum control of significant turf diseases, e.g., dollar spot, brown patch, red thread, and leaf spot.

Surface Insect Control with Light Fertilizer June - July: Controls multiple varieties of lawn damaging insects.

Preventive Fungicide #2

July - August: Extends the effectiveness of disease control further into the summer months.

Grub Control July - August: Prevents late summer damage by killing these pests when they are most active.

Early Fall Fertilizer September - October: Ideal for recovering from the heat stress of summer. Promotes new growth from established turf and provides the necessary nutrients for fall seeding.

Core Aeration September: Loosens compacted soil, permitting a higher availability of nutrients to produce new shoots and roots and thereby improving the overall health of the lawn.

Lime Treatment September - October: An important aspect of lawn care, which brings acidic soil into the proper PH range and maintains the appropriate balance within that range.

Winterization Fertilizer October - November: Nourishes the lawn throughout winter months and provides for quick spring green-up.
